Posters Submit: an abstract discussing your project/research:

1. Knowledge Market learning outcome: Build capacity for collaborative, interprofessional teams prepared to lead community-guided health care, where patients, families and healthcare teams meet.
2. Name of your project/title of abstract.
3. Your full name, credentials and organization
4. Your email and phone number
5. Additional authors
6. Abstract content:
 - a. Problem/Purpose relevant to the knowledge market learning outcome
 - b. Background
 - c. Discussion of issue or concepts/variables of interest
 - d. Population, sample, setting if research & description of community resource
 - e. Methods (research) or interventions (practice/teaching)
 - f. Findings, conclusions & implications
 - g. References

4. Years in existence
5. You will be provided a table to display your information
